RingCentral becomes the exclusive UCaaS partner for Mitel

RingCentral acquires differentiated CloudLink technology to enable a unique transition path from on-premises PBX to RingCentral's Message Video Phone (MVP) cloud platform

RingCentral will pay Mitel \$650 million to acquire intellectual property rights and patents covering network and call management, security, and infrastructure.

Searchlight will invest \$200 million in equity in RingCentral

Mitel gets residual payments from Ring Central for all transitions



Deprecation of Basic Authentication of MS 365

Deprecation of Basic Authentication in Microsoft 365

Microsoft has announced the deprecation of Basic Authentication as of Oct 1, 2022

- New Microsoft 365 tenants are created with Basic Authentication already turned off as they have Security defaults enabled.
- Beginning in early 2021, Microsoft started to disable Basic Authentication for existing tenants with no reported usage.
- Effective October 1, 2022, Microsoft will begin disabling Basic authentication for Outlook, EWS, RPS, POP, IMAP, and EAS protocols. SMTP Auth will also be disabled if it is not being used.

Microsoft recently updated their guidance for tenants using Basic Authentication

 Tenants who need to continue using Basic Authentication can extend their cutover to Modern Authentication (Oauth 2.0) through December 31, 2022






MS Teams Calling Options


